

Carpooling for daily commuting in France





France was a pioneer in carpooling, leading to the emergence of players offering different models

Organised hitchhiking



- Informal carpooling via a mobile app that
- The app notifies drivers of passenger requests for hitchhiking



Carpooling lines



- Physical infrastructure (carpool stops) where passenger and drivers meet
- Request made by the passenger via SMS, app, panel button or hotline




Static carpooling



- Carpool ads website to connect people who share the same route
- Carpoolers then organise the trip by themselves (pickup time and location...)



Dynamic carpooling




Integrated with public transport offering





At the heart of the French strategy: a co-funding model to promote carpooling in the same way as public transport



Art. 15 – French Mobility Law

LTAs can **fund carpool trips** as they fund **public transport**.

Example: in Île-de-France (Paris region), carpooling with a partner platform is included in the Navigo transit pass.

Forfait mobilité durable (= Sustainable mobility budget)

Mechanism to provide **financial support** for **sustainable mobility for employees** in the private and public sectors (tax free up to 800€ per employee per year), including carpooling.

Strong acceleration of carpooling in France in 2022 especially due to rising fuel prices



Nouveau record pour le prix de l'essence en France

National daily carpooling plan: 150M€ invested by the French government to encourage carpooling

3 KEY MESURES

- A 100€ bonus for first-time drivers
- A financial support from the State to fund half of the financial incentives granted by the LTAs to drivers and passengers
- A 50M€ budget to support LTAs in the development of carpooling infrastructure (carpooling areas, carpool lines etc.)

French government presents updated plan to encourage carpooling

The transport and environment ministries are promising €100 to drivers who sign up for carpooling and €100 million to support local authorities in developing incentives.

Significant acceleration in the adoption of carpooling in France thanks to the National carpooling plan



The 3 key measures announced as part of the national daily carpooling plan in 2023 have been extended to 2024.









(excluding Paris city)




...and we thus extend the reach of public transport in rural & suburban areas

(excluding Paris city)






Our model to build carpooling networks
